## FOUNDING MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION OF CENTERS OF FEDERAL STUDIES

On June 21, 1977, representatives of ten institutions concerned with the study of federalism from eight countries convened at the Wenkenhof in Basel, Switzerland, and established an association to further the study and understanding of federal principles and patterns in all their variety. The Association will pursue these goals through: (a) the exchange of information via a semi-annual newsletter, an annual conference, publications, translations, and student and staff exchanges; (b) the stimulation and sponsorship of research on theories and problems of federalism; (c) educational activities to promote public awareness of the potential of federalism in the contemporary world; (d) encouraging the formation of additional institutions concerned with the study of federalism; and (e) the expansion of federal studies among the academic communities of the members' own countries.

The founding members of the Association are: Centre for Research on Federal Financial Relations, Canberra, A.C.T., Australia; Center for the Study of Federalism, Temple University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, U.S.A.; Forschungsinstitut fuer foederalismus und Regionalstrukturen, Riehen, Baselstadt,

Switzerland; Institut fuer Foederalismusstudien, Innsbruck, Austria; Institut européen des hautes études internationales, Nice, France; Institut universitaire d'études européennes, Genève, Switzerland; Institut universitaire d'études fédéralistes, Nice, France; Institute of Intergovernmental Relations, Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario, Canada; Jerusalem Institute for Federal Studies, Jerusalem, Israel; Workshop in Political Theory and Policy Analysis, Indiana University, Bloomington, Indiana, U.S.A.

The Association of Centers for Federal Studies/ Association de Centres d'études du fédéralisme/ Instituts Vereinigung fuer Foederalismusstudien is a non-profit association to foster the scholarly study of federalism. To be eligible for membership, an organization must have the study of federalism as its primary function and purpose. It must be devoted to a scholarly approach and be independent of any particular private or governmental agency in its selection, publication, and dissemination of research. The Secretariat of the Association is the Center for the Study of Federalism, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, U.S.A.
